













This is a priority for the safeguarding partnership.



GLOSSARY

Adult Exploitation	Exploitation is the deliberate manipulation or abuse of power used to have control over another person, usually for some form of gain. This can be for a range of reasons including personal, financial or sexual.	Link
Adverse Childhood Experiences	 Adverse childhood experiences, or ACEs, are potentially traumatic events that occur in childhood (0-17 years). For example: experiencing violence, abuse, or neglect witnessing violence in the home or community having a family member attempt or die by suicide. 	Link
Austerity	a difficult economic situation caused by a government reducing the amount of money it spends.	Link
Co-production	The term co-production refers to a way of working, whereby everybody works together on an equal basis to create a service or come to a decision which works for them all.	Link
Cuckooing	'County lines' networks may use violence and coercion to occupy the property of someone who is often vulnerable through mental health, domestic circumstances, substance misuse or manipulation. The property is used by the network to cut and store drugs and despatch drug runners to perform a deal.	Link
Safeguarding Adults	Protecting an adult's right to live in safety, free from abuse and neglect. It is about people and organisations working together to prevent and stop both the risks and experience of abuse or neglect, while at the same time making sure that the adult's wellbeing is promoted.	Link
Safeguarding Children	 The action that is taken to promote the welfare of children and protect them from harm. protecting children from abuse and maltreatment preventing harm to children's health or development ensuring children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care taking action to enable all children and young people to have the best outcomes. 	Link
